

Botox Lloyminster

Botox Lloyminster - Skin wrinkles are by definition a fold, ridge or crease in the skin. The wrinkles of the skin usually show as a result of aging, consisting of: the extended immersion of the skin in water or glycation. The wrinkling of the skin is a result of habitual facial expressions, sun damage, aging, poor hydration, smoking and various other factors. Skin wrinkles in the water caused by lengthened water exposure that causes the outer layer of skin to absorb water. Depletion of water within the body as with dehydration also can result in the puckering of the skin. Cortisol is one more factor that results in degradation of skin collagen.

To be able to treat wrinkles as well as various skin depressions, dermal fillers are usually used. There are products which are injectable into the soft tissues. Dermal fillers are designed to enable injection into the skin for purposes of improving the skins' appearance. The most well-known products are based on hyaluronic acid.

Botulinum Toxin

The Botulinum toxin is a neurotoxin protein which is made by the bacterium *Clostridium botulinum*. A well-known kind of botulinum toxin is referred to as onabotulinumtoxinA or "Botox". This specific kind of botulinum toxin is made by Allergan Inc. for both therapeutic and cosmetic usage. Botox is made use of in the treatment of migraine headache and cervical dystonia or spasmodic torticollis that is a neuromuscular disorder which involves the head and neck. Botox has numerous uses along with its cosmetic application.

A new form of botulinum toxin became available to the American people in the year 2009. This form is known as Dysport or abotulinumtoxinA and is made by Ipsen. It has been given approval by the FDA and is now made use of in order to treat glabellar lines in grown-ups in addition to cervical dystonia. Botox and Dysport however, are not the same because the molecular structure of the two drugs is different.

The Botulinum toxin efficiently remedies wrinkles by relaxing the muscles that result in wrinkles. It is indicated for the treatment of glabellar lines, those that happen between the eyebrows in adults and is not appropriate for the remedy of all wrinkles. Any other use of this toxin is considered "off-label" use and is not FDA approved.
